Suncorp / QUT research partnership

Suncorp Business Services is financially supporting the Queensland University of Technology's (QUT) successful application for the prestigious Australian Research Council (ARC) Linkage grant.

In 2009, QUT commenced the development of APROMORE – the world's first PHD/real world-created Business Process Management Software.

The product has received global academic recognition for being the world's first open source repository to store and disclose business process models, providing state-of-the-art features for model presentation, analysis, integration, contextualization, improvement, and re-use.

Cameron James and Deborah Mahoney from Suncorp Business Services' BT Applications team, are working alongside the PHD researchers participating in the creation. Along with Suncorp's James Couzens, they will lead and contribute to the quality management and build of APROMORE and ensure that Suncorp gets a return on investment.

Several teams across Personal Insurance and Commercial Insurance have been engaged to contribute "real world" requirements and research, making the most of this rare academic and corporate relationship.
